Year 5 Swimming Lessons

Dear Parents and Carers,

In order to fulfil the Key Stage 2 Physical Education Curriculum, all children in Year 5 must participate in swimming lessons at Bournemouth Collegiate School on a weekly basis starting from Thursday 23rd January 2025. This will be a block of 4 swimming lessons every Thursday morning which will last for 45 minutes, which will be led by qualified swimming coaches.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of **£24.78** to cover the cost of the pool hire and swimming tuition. Please make your payment via magicbooking by **1st April 2025**.

All children must bring the following items for every swimming lesson:

- swimming costume or swim shorts (no bikinis)
- swimming hat
- swimming goggles
- towel
- bag or a rucksack to carry their swimming items
- plastic bag for wet swimming clothes
- water bottle

The children will walk to and from Bournemouth Collegiate School for their swimming lessons. We require additional adult support to walk with the children. If you are able to volunteer, please indicate on the Google form.

It is advised for children to leave any jewellery at home as they will not be allowed to enter the pool with earrings on. Long hair must be tied up (bun or plaited) so that their hair can fit into the swimming cap. If your child has a verruca they must wear a waterproof sock.
