11.0	Headteachers Report	
11.1	Reopening of school SL reported that it was 4 days since the school had returned & that drop off & playtimes were working well. Pick-up times are very busy & SL suggested that it would help if Yr2 left earlier at 3pm - this was agreed. GOV Q (JH) - What time do Reception children leave? 2.50pm.	

	<ul> <li>SL reported that the SIP is also on track:</li> <li>The new Art teacher has started &amp; there is an art room</li> <li>The curriculum work is in progress</li> <li>Spanish is being introduced to KS2.</li> <li>JL confirmed that the Artsmark submission is in progress &amp; is due to be submitted in October - JL will share with Governors prior to submission.</li> </ul>	JL
13.0	School Improvement Plan (SIP)	
	The strategic direction is due to be reviewed 2022. SL confirmed that all is on track & this will be reviewed again at the next meeting.	Clerk
12.0	Strategic direction, vision & values	
11.3	AMS to ensure that in any communication any family in hardship can approach the school <u>Attendance</u> Governors noted that the attendance levels were slightly lower than normal at this point in the term & agreed that it was good that parents were keeping children home if there was any risk that they were unwell. <i>GOV Q (AB) - How are you managing with the limited number of toilets</i> ? SL reported that the long term goal would be to have gender neutral toilets but currently only 3 children are allowed in the toilet at one time. This is not a big issue & there is little queueing. Governors noted that there is more space in the corridors now that there are no lockers. AMS keen to cost door removal and renovation where necessary as benefits for infection control and behaviour monitoring Governors discussed the arrangements for lunch & the time allowed for eating.	SL/ F&R
11.2	Governors discussed social distancing & mask wearing & noted that many parents do not seem to be doing this - SL agreed to send a reminder to parents which will also encourage them to take precautions. This led to a discussion on keep left markings on pathways, notices on the gates & banners on the railings - SL to consider. JH offered that BCP may have 'prompt materials' available for schools. <u>Uniform</u> SL reported that the KS2 PE uniform is currently black plimsolls, but since these will be worn all day it would be better to have black trainers with minimal branding - Governors agreed to this & asked SL to explain the reason for this to parents.	

<ul> <li>to meet applicants, as had initially been agreed last year.</li> <li>Mass MP asked if Mass could re-start for separate year groups - SL to approach Father Adrian. Agreed that this would be best in the School Hall &amp; that no parents will be able to attend.</li> <li>Link Governors JH asked how this will work when Governors are not able to attend school. It was proposed that link Governors could meet with subject leads via Zoom, but this will be added to the next SIPS agenda. SL to ask subject leads for their views on this prior to the SIPS meeting. SL to also send out a list of the link Governors &amp; their subject areas.</li> <li>Date of next meeting – 7th December 2020</li> </ul>	SL/ SL/ Clerk
