


This half term, our Curriculum Enquiry Question is
When do a person's actions have an impact?

RE	Catholic Character Education/RSHE	English	
<p><u>Lent</u> In RE, we will be looking at what the season of Lent is for and considering why it is a special time to show compassion.</p> <p><u>Holy Week</u> We will also be focusing on the events of the Last Supper and will consider the connections they have to Mass today.</p> <p>As part of our learning about other faiths, we will learn about Islam and the holy pilgrimage to Mecca, called Hajj.</p>	<p><u>CCE:</u> We are focussing on the qualities it takes to show courage, such as resilience, perseverance and bravery. We will understand that these skills can be shown in the smallest of ways and draw inspiration from our role models such as Malala Yousafzai.</p> <p><u>RSHE:</u> We are doing some learning based on how to have healthy and positive friendships and will discuss other relationships in our life too. We will also discuss the effect of alcohol and drugs on someone's body and understand the dangers.</p>	<p>We will begin with focussing on the natural world around us and writing balanced arguments and having debates.</p> <p>We will be reading two fiction texts based on life during the Tudor times to link with our Topic work. We will be using these to write an explanation text based on all our cross-curricular learning.</p> <p>We will finish by writing some Poetry and explore developing our skills using prose and free verse, with Space as an inspiration.</p>	
Maths	History	Arts and Culture	
<p>This half term, we will revisit our learning on fractions and build upon this knowledge. We will focus on how to multiply unit, non-unit and mixed number fractions to complete problems.</p> <p>In addition to our learning on fractions, we will also explore decimals and percentages including how to convert between the two. We will come to understand how this knowledge serves its purpose by applying it to real life contexts and problems.</p>	<p>As we move away from geography in year 5, we move back to studying an aspect of history; The Tudors. In this unit of work the children will come to understand when in time The Tudors took place in relation to our other studies of time and consider the impact and legacies left behind by key figures such as Henry VIII and Elizabeth I. Furthermore, the conflict between different religious groups and how this was resolved will also be explored alongside conflicts that took place further afield during this period of history.</p>	<p><u>Design and Technology:</u> In DT we will be developing sewing skills and practising different embroidery stitches.</p>	<p><u>Spanish:</u> We will be learning about 'Los Planetos' to link with our Science topic.</p> <p><u>Computing:</u> Programming using microbits.</p>

Science	PE	Curriculum Texts
<p>Our focus in science this half term is space and gravity. We will look at describing the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system, the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth, describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies and consider how night and day occur and what impact this has on Earth.</p>	<p><u>Outdoor PE:</u> Our focus for indoor PE is tag rugby. In this unit of work, the children will learn the fundamentals of the game - rugby - whilst also learning how to adapt in a team situation and apply tactics to a game.</p> <p><u>Indoor PE:</u> Swimming</p>
