<p>In maths we will continue to recap and revise our learning about multiplication and division.</p> <p>We will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes and their properties before moving on to learn about fractions and position and direction.</p>	<p>In History we will be learning about the sinking of the Titanic. We will be investigating what life was like aboard The Titanic for 1st, 2nd and 3rd class passengers and debating about why The Titanic sank.</p> 	<p>Art: In Art we will be learning about artists that think about environmental issues and concentrating on making 3D models.</p> <p>Music: In music children will be developing their knowledge of the glockenspiel to include sea shanty melodies. They will be learning how to play 'The drunken sailor' using a greater contrast of techniques, rhythms and pitches.</p>	<p>Computing: The children will continue to learn about online safety and practise their typing skills.</p>
Science	PE	Curriculum Texts	
<p>Animals, Including Humans: Growth and Survival.</p> <p>In Science, we will consider why animals have babies, then match parent animals to their offspring. We will begin to learn about the animals which give birth to live offspring, and those that lay eggs. We will observe chicken eggs hatch into chicks.</p> <p>We will learn about ways in which the body grows over time, describing some changes in our own words, and conducting a height investigation.</p> <p>As a class, we will think about the basic needs of animals, such as eating, drinking and breathing. We will then consider how these needs vary between different species, then explain the needs of various animals in our own words.</p>	<p>In PE, children have been refining their ball skills using both their hands and feet. Therefore, they will now be able to apply these skills in games and competitive situations. The children will also be learning about gymnastics and creating patterns of movement.
