

RE	Catholic Character Education/RSHE	English	
<p>Lent: Children will learn that Lent is a time when we prepare for Easter and how this preparation involves change. We will learn that forgiveness and penance can be expressed in many and various ways, but above all in fasting, prayer and almsgiving.</p> <p>Holy Week: We are focusing on the events of the Last Supper and will consider the connections they have to mass today.</p>	<p>CCE: In CCE, we will be looking at self-control. Children will be learning the importance of self-control both in and out of the classroom setting. We will reflect on suitable Bible stories which demonstrate self-control.</p> <p>RSHE: In RSHE, we will be learning about health and wellbeing, with a focus on oral hygiene and how to look after your teeth. The children will learn about what a healthy diet looks like, and how their diet can impact their health and wellbeing and teeth.</p>	<p>Fiction: Fantasy Portal Stories We will be reading and writing stories where characters travel through portals to fantasy worlds. Children will develop their ability to write imaginatively, using expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and similes, as well as a rich vocabulary to enhance their writing.</p> <p>Non Fiction- Persuasive writing- Holiday brochure We will be making a cross curricular link to our Geography topic of Poland and the children will be creating a holiday brochure. Children will develop their ability to include rhetorical questions, strong arguments and emotive language.</p>

<p>In Maths, we will continue to learn about length and perimeter, with a focus on measuring using millimetres, centimeters and metres. We will then move on to fractions, understanding numerators, denominators and non-unit fractions.</p>	<p>In Geography, we will be learning about Poland. The Children will learn where Poland is on the map, human and physical features of Poland, and they will learn about the capital cities in Poland including Warsaw.</p>	<p>DT: The children will be exploring weaving and linking it to the Iron Age. Music: The children will be exploring how to compose and Create: Pentatonic Melodies</p>	<p>Spanish: La fruta (fruit) we will learn about the different fruits and how to say 'I like' and 'I don't like'.</p>

<p>Humans/Animals Children will learn to identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. We will compare and contrast the diets of different animals and decide ways of grouping them according to what they eat. We will research different food groups and how they keep us healthy, and design meals based on what we find out.</p>	<p>Inside PE: Kurling and archery. These are two news sports being introduced to the children.</p> <p>Outside PE: Communication and tactics games.
