**Welcome:**

Magda welcomed everyone to the meeting and introduced herself and explained what the PTA is there for. To raise money for the school, to help fund projects they wouldn't be able to do otherwise, as well as to run events for the children to enjoy.

**Financial Update:**

Magda took over in April 2025.  
In April there was £1500 in the account.  
£6166.70 at the end of Summer Term 2025.  
£7976.16 in account now.

**Events run this academic year.**

These events have made £3400.

Expenses this term - Christmas gifts for children, lottery licence, insurance, books for library, SEN toys.

After expenses the profit so far is £2688.14.

**Committee:**
