Year 3 Recorders

I am excited to share that **pupils in Year 3 will be learning to play the Recorder** in their weekly music lessons during the Summer Term. Learning to play the Recorder is a fun way to improve music literacy, finger coordination, and breath control, preparing students for future music learning. In Year 4, there is an option to take individual music tuition in flute or clarinet. Learning to play the Recorder will also help prepare pupils who wish to take up this offer next academic year.

All pupils in Year 3 will receive their own Recorder, which is **on loan** from our local Music Hub, SoundStorm. Your child will bring his or her Recorder home each week to practise skills they have learned in their lesson. Please encourage your child to practise at home as much as possible. The more they practise, the better they will sound!

Pupils will be required to bring their Recorder to school every Tuesday for their music lesson. I would suggest that Recorders are kept in school bags at all times when they are not practising to ensure that they are not forgotten at home.

We are lucky to be able to provide instruments to all our pupils at no cost to you. However, the Recorders must be looked after carefully and returned to school at the end of the school year. **A charge of £5 will be applied to any Recorders which are damaged or not returned.**

If your child already has a Recorder at home, they are welcome to use it, provided it is in good condition.
