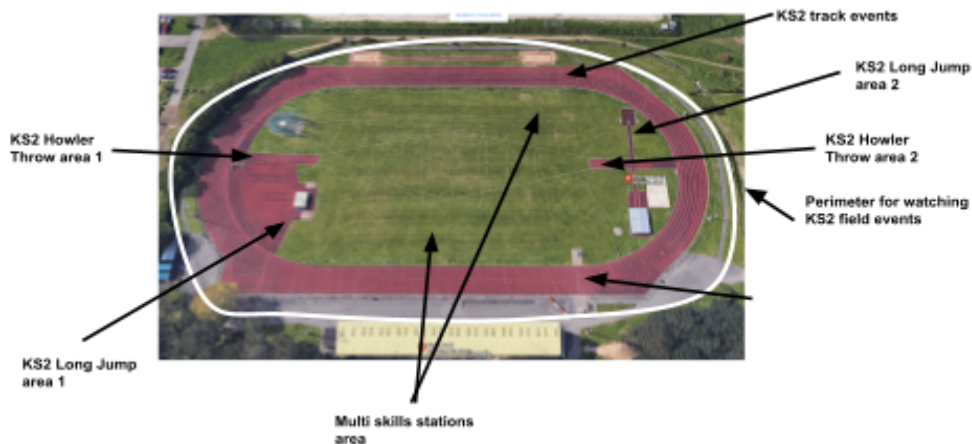

Key Stage 2 Sports Day - Friday 26th June 2026

Sports Day for Years 3-6 will take place on **Friday 26th June at King's Park Athletic Stadium.**

The children should wear their **house coloured PE t-shirt** (Walsingham, Lourdes, Fatima or Carmel) along with the rest of their PE kit to school as they will be staying in PE kit for the remainder of the day. If you would like to walk to King's Park from School with your child's class, please meet outside the school gate at 9am. The schedule for Sports Day will be as follows:

KS2 Sports Day

- 09:00** Years 3 & 5 children will leave school to walk to King's Park Stadium
- 09:20** Opening Ceremony & Warm-up
- 09:30** Field events will commence for Years 3 & 5
- 10:00** Years 4 & 6 children will leave school to walk to King's Park Stadium
- 10:30** Track events will commence for Years 3 & 5/ field events for Years 4 & 6
- 11:00** Years 3 & 5 will walk back to school
- 11:30** Track events will commence for Years 4 & 6
- 12:00** Years 4 & 6 will walk back to school

We do ask that you ensure your child/children has a water bottle and a sun-hat for the morning. Please apply sunscreen before your child comes to school (this is dependent on hot weather).

Parents and carers are warmly invited to spectate. You will be able to access the stands or walk the entire perimeter of the track (outside the fence) to observe the events. **Parents will not have access to the athletics track. It is important that children stay with their class at all times during the events so we ask parents to avoid calling their children over for photos etc.**
