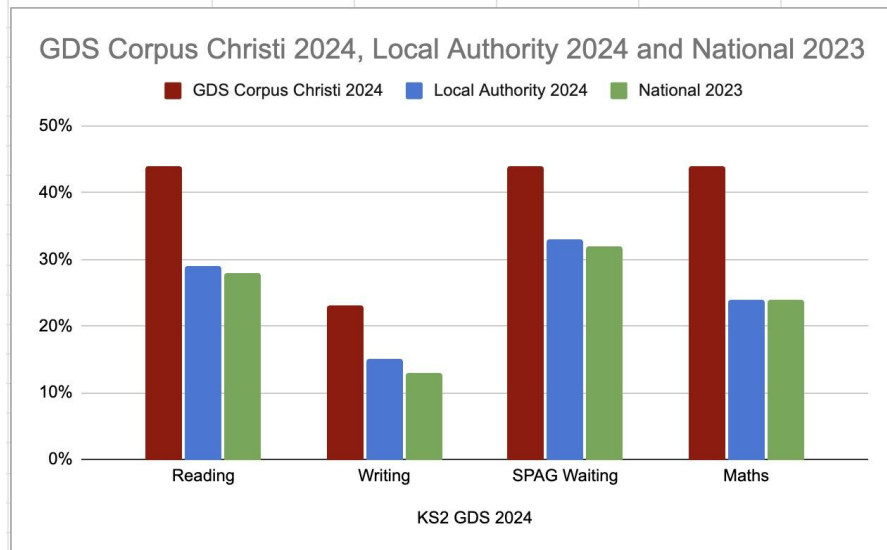

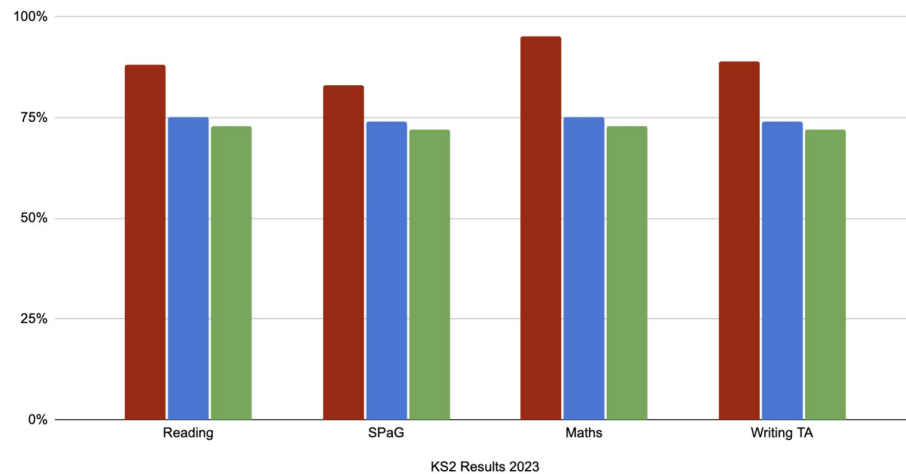

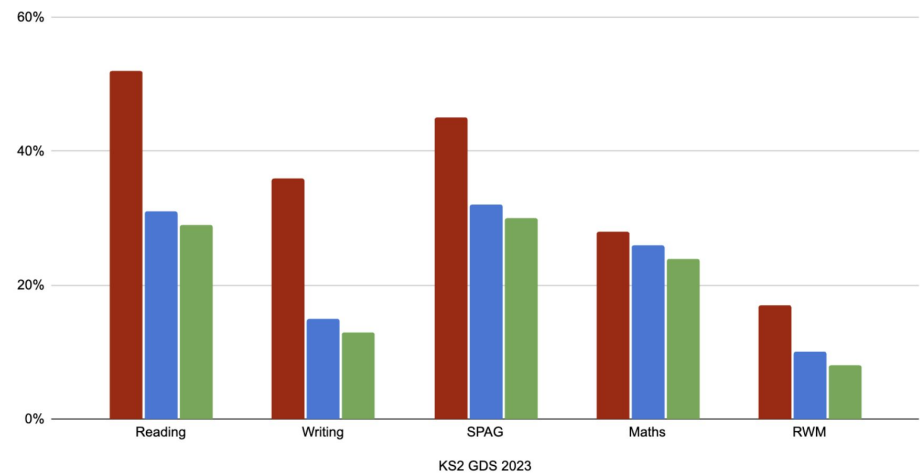

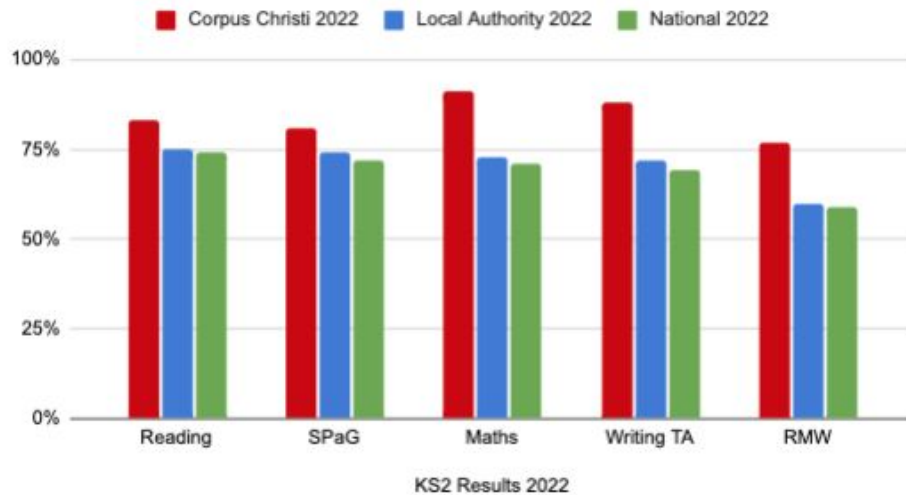

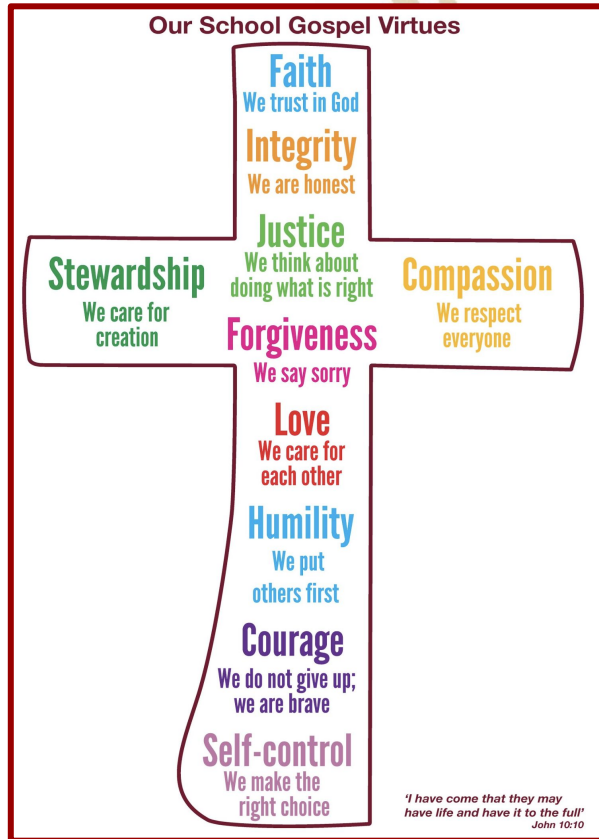


Character Education

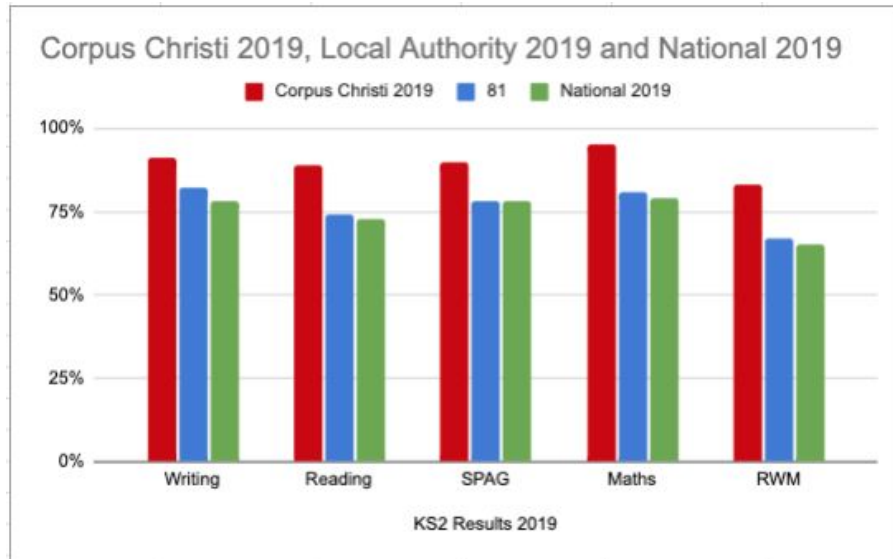


Our ten School Gospel Virtues are the basis for our Catholic Character Education at Corpus Christi

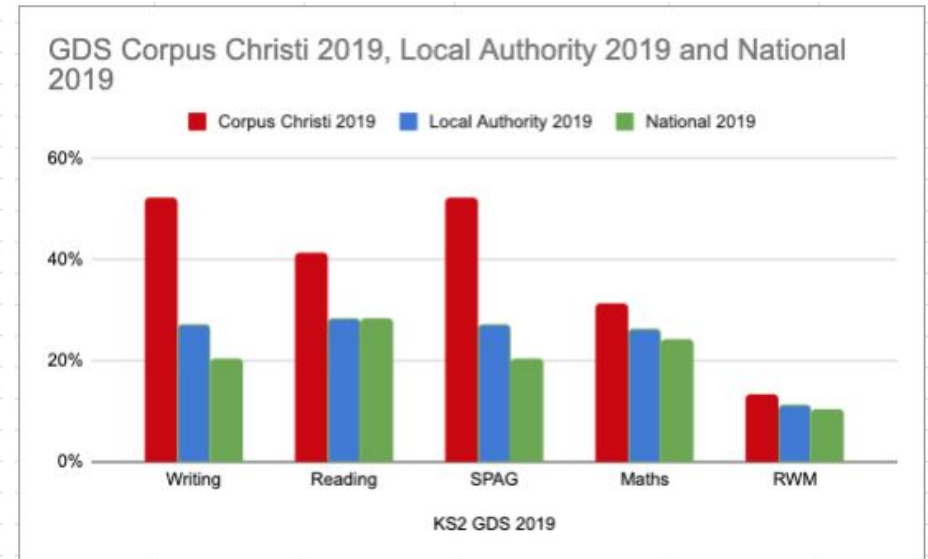
