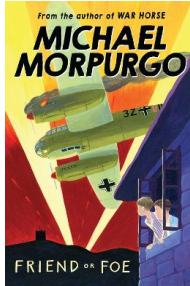
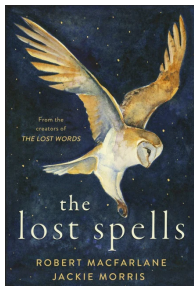

We will think about why and how we remember the tragedies of the past.	Art/DT: The children will be designing and making their own healthy vegetable tart.They will be exploring the nutrition and health benefits of different foods. Music: WW2: Pupils will develop an understanding of the styles of music civilians and soldiers during this period and learn how to play a simple swing/jazz piece of music on an instrument. Spanish: Language Angels -WWII and Healthy eating. Computing: We will learn the importance of secure passwords, and using searching and word processing skills to create a presentation. We will use programming software to understand hacking, relating this to computer cracking codes in WWII.
Science	PE	Curriculum Texts
Light Children will learn about the impact of Newton on our understanding of light. They will also learn about heat hazes and mirages. Children will conduct their own shadow investigations. They will learn about x-rays and how scientists can use them to treat people and animals. They will also learn about eclipses.	Indoor: Health Related Exercise Our indoor focus will challenge the children to think critically about their health and the need for fitness. The children will be consolidating and deepening their knowledge and skills about health related exercise by partaking in a variety of health related exercises . Outdoor: Running Our outdoor focus for the next 6 weeks is running. The children will consolidate what they learnt last year by partaking in a variety of running formats such as sprinting, middle & long distance and hurdles.
