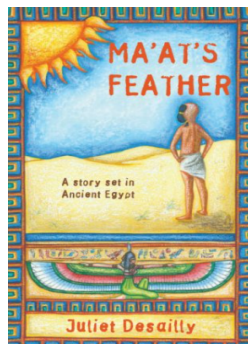
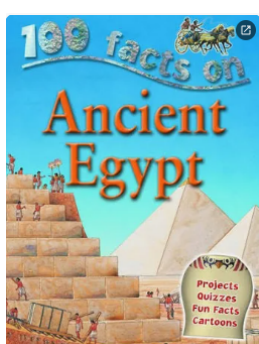

RE	Catholic Character Education/RSHE	English	
We will begin by exploring our school mission statement and thinking about how through our actions we can make the world a ‘better place’. We will also celebrate and share our ‘special gifts’ with the class. Creation and covenant The children will explore the first account of creation in the book of Genesis, through this they will think about stewardship and human dignity. The children will also think about what they can do to demonstrate stewardship in our school and the wider local community. The Children will also learn about Saint Francis of Assisi as a role model for ecological virtues.	In CCE, we will be exploring our school Gospel Virtues, particularly focused on love. The children will develop their understanding of love and think about how we can show love to others, both in the classroom and as part of the wider school community. Non-Fiction- Linking in their knowledge of Ancient Egypt, Children will create a non-chronological report on Ancient Gods and Goddesses. Poetry- Children will explore haiku poetry, creating their own one on the pyramids.

Place Value: Children will identify, represent and estimate numbers in a number of different ways. They will find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number. Alongside this, children will recognise the value of each digit in a three digit number and explore numbers up to 1000 on a number line.	History- Ancient Egypt Children will be learning about what Ancient Egypt was like and who the Ancient Egyptians were. Children will learn about how the Egyptians treated their Pharaohs and explore the life of Tutankhamen. Alongside this, the children will explore hieroglyphics and mummification. In Science we will be exploring light. Firstly the children will discover where light comes from, as well as understanding the difference between light and darkness.
